Project direction:

o <u>Technical oversight</u>:

- Designing methodologies and projects workplans in coordination with clients and project teams
- Managing project delivery teams to ensure high quality delivery by providing precise technical direction all along the project life cycle

Coordination:

- Ensuring that project management systems and processes are in place and being delivered by senior PM/PM/analyst.
- Tracking and ensuring the respect of project timelines, resourcing, and budgets;
- Ensuring the timely delivery of the project;

- Providing practical solutions to technical and project management delivery challenges;
- Taking decisions related to project security, timelines, resourcing, and budgets;
